Fees

- Annual tuition fee: 535,800 JPY (approx. 5000 USD)
- Living expenses and rent: 80,000 JPY per month (approx. 720 USD)

Financial Aid

- NU Global 30 Undergraduate Scholarship
- ⇒ Based on merit and need
- ⇒ Lasts for 4 years
- ⇒ 100% tuition and registration fee waiver
- ⇒ Annual stipend of 500,000 JPY (approx. 4500 USD)
- Tuition waiver scheme available after enrolment

Housing available for the first year

- 32,000 JPY per month, plus utilities (approx. 300 USD)
- Single room, furnished

Admissions

- ONLINE Application
- October intake
- NO Japanese proficiency required
- Japanese passport holders eligible*
*2 out of the last 3 years outside of Japanese education system

Required documents

- (Prospective) Graduation Diploma
- Transcripts
- Standardized Test Scores, optional
- English Language Proficiency, if applicable
- Two Recommendation Letters
- Two Essays

Deadlines:

- 1st round (main): Nov 15 to Dec 12
- 2nd round: Jan 15 to Feb 6 (certain programs only)
